PLUM COULEE APRIL 2026 POLICE ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

On the 5th of April Police received a call from a resident in Plum Coulee advising that he had repossessed a vehicle and the former owner had come by and removed stereo equipment from the vehicle. The vehicle was now being stored indoors. As this matter is now civil in nature, the complainant was advised how to proceed in civil litigation.

On the 21st of April Police were called about a possible unsafe storage of firearms at a residence in Plum Coulee. Complainant advised that the firearms had recently been moved to a friends place due to a marital issue. Police confirmed with the “friend” that the firearms were now stored at his residence.

On the 22nd of April Police were called to a gas station in Plum Coulee in regards to a complaint of alcohol theft. 4 persons entered the store, and stole alcohol from the shelf, before running out of the building, into a vehicle and fleeing. Police continue to investigate.

On the 24th of April Ambulance dispatch called reporting an unresponsive male at an apartment complex in Plum Coulee. Police learnt that the adult male had taken Fentanyl. Male was transported to hospital by EMS.

Police received further complaints of motorists speeding on Government Road from Hwy 14 towards Russell St. Police will again conduct extensive patrols in this area to address the issue.
